

Cash Management Administrator

There are a range of important tasks in the operation of SIPP's which Administrators can handle which include the identification of receipts, the management of direct debits, the identification and processing of contributions and RAS claims and contact with 3rd parties, advisers and clients.

The ideal candidate would have a prior proven experience of working within an office environment and dealing with general daily administration and working to deadlines. Knowledge, skills and experience will be assessed on joining and gaps will be identified so that suitable training can be given.

The Position and Duties will include;

- Submitting of bank transactions to the company's administration system (SIPP Pro), ensuring this is processed within a timely manner.
- The creation of parent and child tasks within the Task Management System
- The identification and processing of unassigned items; including 3rd party, adviser or client contact
- The identification and processing of pension scheme contributions.
- Direct debit set up
- Cash sweeps
- Processing RAS claims – monthly and annual returns as required
- Where relevant and appropriate, informing Account Managers and any other internal stakeholders of specific matters or issues
- Ensuring that internal deadlines are met, escalating to Senior Administrator or Team Leader any issues
- Providing support to the Disbursements Team as required

The applicants must possess a high degree of interpersonal skills and be able to prioritise workloads on a daily basis to accord with the Company's service levels.
