

Test analyst: Mid or senior level

We are looking for a test analyst to join our team to work closely with the established development team defining, creating and managing testing of a growing number of internally developed applications. Although the development team has testing experience, the role will be a new one in Curtis Banks to improve and build on the existing manual and automated test scripts. The candidate should be able to translate specifications and use cases into a set of executable tests and manage the process and outputs. This role is an opportunity to be involved in a number of new projects as well as exposure to a wide range of technologies in a professional environment. This role would suit an individual with existing testing experience or involvement in the testing process as a developer. The ideal candidate will be enthusiastic, diligent and able to work closely with the development team.

The existing suite of applications is predominately open source web based. The current testing process and automation is currently in an incipient stage using protractor with a plan to integrate with a tool such as Browserstack for cross-browser testing. The team are open to other solutions should they prove to be better than currently being developed. Any familiarity with web based testing and the modern tools to automate it will be a huge advantage.

Candidates who are standards aware with certification such as ISEB and ISTQB and familiar with Jira and Confluence are preferred. The candidate should have experience scripting automated tests, with a strong preference towards Javascript, as well as a good working knowledge of Git for version control. Full training on internal and company processes will be provided.

The candidate will be required to be involved in the specification process, to better understand the testing requirements for new functionality, including the review of requirements. The applicants must possessing a high degree of interpersonal skills and be able to prioritise workloads on a daily basis to accord with the Company's service levels.
